Program Tour:

Day 1: Amman (Arrival)	(L, D)
<p>Upon arrival, meet and greet by English speaking driver guide and proceed to Amman city. The current and ancient capital of Jordan, Amman is a modern city with many conveniences; It is a good base for touring Jordan, visit both the old city which are: Souq, Roman Amphitheater with Jordan Museum of popular tradition and Jordan Folklore Museum, Amman Citadel with Temple of Hercules, Byzantine Church, Omayyad Palace and Archaeological Museum and new parts of the city.</p> <p>Amman is steeped in biblical history known as the capital of the Ammonites as Rabbath Ammon, and as Philadelphia in the Roman rule, it became the southern Greco-Roman city of the Decapolis. A Roman amphitheater with capacity of 8000 spectator's. The citadel which still standing with its columns & numerous Roman-Byzantine & Islamic remains. Excavations showed that Amman goes back 9,000 years from Neolithic - Roman- Greco - Byzantine to Islamic. Remains of churches & Umayyad Palace, The Archaeological museum with some of Dead Sea scrolls & Islamic treasures and the Popular Traditions museum.</p>	
Day 2: Amman- Jerash - Ajloun - Umm Qais - Amman	(B, L, D)
<p>Breakfast served in hotel, start the sightseeing to Jerash.</p> <p>Jerash: One of the 10 commercial cities of the Decapolis In the 1st Century, It is the best example in the Middle-East of a Roman provincial city, And is remarkably well preserved. 51 Km. North of Amman And is Jordan's second most important tourist attraction.</p> <p>Ajloun:- The main attraction at Ajloun is a castle, Qala' Al-Rabad which sits atop a hill covered with pine forests and olive groves, The castle was built in 1184-1185, and is an excellent example of Islamic Military Architecture.</p> <p>Umm Qais: Located in northwest Jordan, Umm Qais overlooks the Golan Heights and the Sea of Galilee, The area, which is reputed to have the oldest olive trees in the region, is the site of the ancient Greco-Roman town of Gardena one of the cities of the Decapolis.</p> <p>Lunch at local reastaurant and dinner at hotel.</p> <p>(Remark: Included 2 hours English speaking city guide in Jerash sites only)</p>	
Day 3: Amman - Petra	(B, L, D)
<p>Breakfast served in hotel, check out hotel and drive estimated 3 hours (240KM) journey to Petra . The famous rock city, is located in the south of Jordan, and was created by the Nabataean Arabs. Since 1985 Petra belongs to the World Heritage Sites and since 2007 it is one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. The Nabateans settled here more than 2000 years ago and carved temples, tombs and houses in the red rose sandstone. When this nomadic Arabs showed up on the historical stage is not clear, the first definite historical mention of them is in 312 BC. They gained power through the control of the silk, spice and other trade routes that linked Asia and southern Arabia with Egypt, Syria, Greece and Rome. In the first century BC King Aretas III extended the Nabatean Empire to Damascus. Important for the Nabatean success was their ability to create a sophisticated water supply system with channels and cisterns. Petra was chosen as the capital because it was located in a valley surrounded by sandstone mountains. (Including horse ride untill the Siq-800m). Visitors enter Petra through the Siq, a narrow gorge, over 1 km in length, which is flanked by 80 metres high cliffs. Just walking through the Siq is an experience in itself. The colours and formations of the rocks are dazzling. As you reach the end of the Siq you will catch your first glimpse of Al Khazneh, known as the Treasury. Its name comes from the Bedouin belief that the Pharaoh hid his treasure in the urn at the top of the Kazneh. The monument consists of a massive façade, 30 meters wide and 43 meters high, carved out of the red rose sandstone in in the early 1st century, walk along the Street of Facades, lined with tall monuments, after you see on the right side the so called Royal Tombs. Climbing up stairs the Urn Tomb, the Silk Tomb with rich coloured sandstone, the Corinthian and the Palace Tomb can be found. Buffet lunch inside ruins and dinner at hotel. Overnight at Petra. (Included 2 hours English speaking city guide in Petra sites only)</p> <p>(Remarks: Excluded Carriage ride in Petra-USD 30 for 2 persons, USD 03-05 per person for the Petra Bedouin Horse man)</p>	
Day 4: Petra - Wadi Rum - Amman	(B, L, D)
<p>Breakfast served in hotel, check out hotel and drive estimated 2 hours journey to Wadi Rum . This city offers extraordinary desert scenery, colorful hills and canyons and challenging climbs for novice or serious hiker. Where the movie "Lawrence of Arabia and Red Planet" was filmed is a uniquely shaped massive mountain that rose amongst the rosy red sand of desert with towering cliffs of various brownish, reddish, and golden colors. Explore it by 2 hours 4 wheels drive and short walk around. Experience a lunch under the tent. Drive 3 hours journey back to Amman, dinner at hotel, check in to Amman Hotel.</p> <p>(Remark: Excluded tips for the Bedouin Vehicle in Wadi Rum- expected USD 07 per vehicle, maximum 06 persons per vehicle)</p>	
Day 5: Amman - Madaba, Mount Nebo, Dead Sea- Amman	(B, L, D)
<p>Breakfast served in hotel, first stop will visit to Madaba.</p> <p>Madaba: Only 30 Km. south of Amman, This lovely town is home to St. George's Church which Houses a 6th century Byzantine Mosaic Map, Showing ancient Palestine, Egypt, Jerusalem and other holy sites.</p> <p>Mount Nebo: The most revered site in Jordan, Mount Nebo is presumed to be the site of Moses' Death and burial place, Mount Nebo offers breathtaking views of the Jordan Valley, Dead Sea and Rooftops of Jerusalem and Bethlehem. Atop Mount Nebo is a Franciscan Church with beautiful 4th and 6th century</p> <p>According to the Bible, it is the place from where Moses viewed the Promised Land in Canaan, and where he died and was buried in a nearby valley.</p> <p>Dead Sea: The lowest point on the surface of the earth, The Dead Sea at 400 meters below sea level has a 33% salt content, Which makes any plant or animal life impossible? Take a dip in its waters for a very unusual Experience, or optional for a spa treatment with Dead Sea mud and minerals at one of the area hotels. You can enjoy the salty beach with it is sand in Dead Sea Spa Hotel beach, after return to Amman.</p> <p>(Remarks: Excluded towel & clothes & swimming suit are recommended during Dead Sea tour, lockers/towels during dead sea charge USD 3.5 per person per item)</p>	
Day 6: Amman - Desert Castles - Amman (Departure)	(B, L, D)
<p>Breakfast served in hotel, check out hotel. Drive around 1 hour jouney to Desert Castles. First visit to Qaser Kharaneh (55 kilometers from Amman) is one of the best preserved of the Umayyad Castles. The Castle stands two stories high and although only 35 square meters, it is one of the most impressive sights with its towers exaggerating its height. Next we visit to Qaser Amra (85 kilometers from Amman) is well-known for its 8th Century fresco paintings on the walls and the many mosaics and marble claddings telling tales of the time of Caliph Walid I, as far back as 705 AD. Continue visit to Qaser El-Azraq is an Oasis settlement lying along the caravan route from the Arabian Peninsula to Syria and Jordan. The fort is made of black basalt and is assumed to have been first built in the late Roman period, and rebuilt during the Ayyubids. Transfer back to Amman city, Lunch and dinner at local restaurant. You may enjoy your shopping time in Down town (Shopping Area/Bazaar/New Malls) until your meeting time for transfer to airport for flight departure.</p>
